22/28. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

22/29. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

The minutes of 22 February 2022 were approved as a correct record of events. **Proposed: Cllr Daniels. Seconded: Cllr Harrison. All agreed.**

22/30. PROGRESS CHECK / ACTION PLAN.

Church Hill – work is on schedule to finish on time. Thanks were noted to Cllr Playle for going above and beyond his responsibility to help with the traffic control. **Dog fouling signs** – these have now been put up by the allotments.

22/32. PUBLIC FORUM.

Speeding – was there anything else that could be done such as installing speed cameras? The Parish Council has purchased an additional speed indicator device and now has five volunteers for Community Speed Watch.

Tree replacement in Vicarage Avenue – it was suggested that two trees could be planted, however permission would be needed and ongoing future maintenance would have to be considered.

Christmas Tree – instead of buying a tree each year could one be planted? It was explained that they are difficult to grow and again would need ongoing maintenance once it reached a certain height.

Speed Indicator Device (SID) Report – Cllr Bentley gave a report of the recent traffic data and although traffic has reduced due to the road closure, the speeds are still high.
