MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 28 FEBRUARY 2012 AT WHITE NOTLEY VILLAGE HALL AT 7.30 PM.

12/02. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Fraser, Harrison and McKoy.

12/03. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

The minutes of 24 January 2012 were approved as a correct record of events.

- **Police/ PCSO Report.** There were no incidents to report, however it was noted that the Mobile Police Station will stop at the end of March, it is not yet known if it will continue.
- **District Councillors Report.** At the full council meeting it was agreed that the Council Tax is to be frozen again for 2012/13.
- County Councillors Report. Cllr Lager gave a report on County Council matters, there will be no increase in Council Tax, the only authority raising their precept is the Police at 3.5%.

12/07. COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH AND SPEED INDICATOR DEVICE (SID).

A brief update was given, it was noted that Church Hill has quite high speeds. The new battery has now been received so data will continue to be downloaded as normal.

12/08. FAULKBOURNE TO WITHAM ~ SPEEDING ISSUES.

The County Council are currently in the process of carrying out a speed review of all A and B roads to establish whether the speed limit currently in place is suitable for the location, this review will be followed by a review of all the unclassified roads, including Witham Road (Faulkbourne). When putting the case for a reduction in the current speed limit it was suggested that 50mph would be more realistic and to quote the number of rising accidents including the number of access points along this road.
