17/12. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

17/13. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

17/16. PUBLIC FORUM.

Village Sign – over £140 has been raised by residents to help with the repair of the sign. As Mr Underwood did not want payment for his work, he wanted to do it for the village, it was suggested that the money raised could be split between the Church and a new War Memorial (in agreement with those who had contributed).

District Council – apologies were received from Cllr Bebb. Cllr Hufton-Rees mentioned the Ward Members Fund and there was still time to apply. He also said any information on any increase in fly-tipping would be welcome.

County Council – apologies were received from Cllr Abbott, an emailed report was received: ECC will be raising its share of council tax by 3% which is entirely to help fund social care using the new mechanism that the Government has introduced which allows a 6% rise over 3 years for social care, but which can be brought forward to 2x3% in the first 2 years. The core council tax level for all other services is not changing.

Cllr Abbott also mentioned the changes to the arrangements at the Witham Recycling Centre, which combined with the suspension of green waste collections by BDC is leading to complaints, and is hopeful that some improvements may be secured.
